

Dear Players,

I hope this will clear everything up so that everyone is on the same page.

All events are based on amount of players. For example:

- \$500 added is based on 32 players
- \$1,000 added is based on 45 players
- \$2,000.00 added is based on 64 players

\$500 added one day event breakdown:

- House receives \$5.00 per player
- End of year fund gets \$5.00 per player
- The director gets \$7.00 per player

Out of \$45.00 entry: \$17.00 per player gets deducted and \$28.00 goes into the pot from each player. If the tournament does not generate the full 32 players, then the added is pro rated to \$15.00 per player. So if there are 27 players, the added amount is \$405, instead of the full \$500.

\$1,000 added one day event breakdown:

- House receives \$7.00 per player
- End of year fund gets \$5.00 per player
- The director gets \$7.00 per player

Out of \$45.00 entry: \$19.00 per player gets deducted and \$26.00 goes into the pot from each player. If the tournament does not generate the full 45 players, then the added is pro rated to \$22.00 per player. So if there are 40 players, the added amount is \$880, instead of the full \$1,000.

\$2,000 added two day event breakdown:

- House receives \$7.00 per player
- End of year fund gets \$5.00 per player
- The director gets \$8.00 per player

Out of \$45.00 entry: \$20.00 per player gets deducted and \$25.00 goes into the pot from each player. If the tournament does not generate the full 64 players, then the added is pro rated to \$31.00 per player. So if there are 50 players, the added amount is \$1,550, instead of the full \$2,000.

\$8,000 added two day event (Winter classic) breakdown:

- House receives \$10.00 per player
- End of year fund gets \$5.00 per player
- The director gets \$15.00 per player

Out of \$75.00 entry: \$30.00 per player gets deducted and \$45.00 goes into the pot from each player. If the tournament does not generate the full 128 players, then the added is pro rated to \$61.50 per player. So if there are 90 players, the added will be \$5,535, instead of the full \$8,000.00.

Please note: We also have free entry winners from the 2010-2011 season. There are a total of three players. We give a discount for out of state players. They receive \$5.00 off their entry fee. All female players receive \$10.00 off their entry fee. These discounts do not apply to the Winter Classic or the Tour Championship tournaments.
